**GAIL BOUDREAUX** is Chief Executive Officer of UnitedHealthcare. Ms. Boudreaux is responsible for the largest business division of UnitedHealth Group, which provides health benefits to more than 38 million individuals, and manages a workforce of more than 50,000 employees. With a market-leading ability to meet the health care needs of consumers across all stages of life, from birth to retirement, UnitedHealthcare manages health benefits for individuals, employers and public sector groups, state Medicaid programs and Medicare beneficiaries. Previously, Ms. Boudreaux served as President of UnitedHealthcare's commercial and individual business.

Before joining UnitedHealthcare, she served as Executive Vice President, External Operations for Health Care Service Corporation through April 2008. Ms. Boudreaux had spent 20 years at Aetna holding a number of regional and national leadership positions for the Group Insurance business unit prior to joining Health Care Service Corporation.

Ms. Boudreaux earned a B.A. with honors from Dartmouth College and an M.B.A. in Finance and Health Care Administration from Columbia Business School.

While at Dartmouth, Ms. Boudreaux was a highly honored member of the women's basketball team. In 1999, Ms. Boudreaux was named to the Ivy League's 25-year anniversary team in basketball and Dartmouth College's 25-year anniversary teams in both basketball and track & field. In 2003, Ms. Boudreaux was inducted into the New England Basketball Hall of Fame and was one of six individuals nationally to receive the NCAA's Silver Anniversary Award for outstanding professionalism and athletic achievement. She currently serves on Dartmouth College's Board of Trustees.

Additionally, Ms. Boudreaux serves on the Board of Directors for America's Health Insurance Plans (AHIP), the industry's trade association. She also is on the Board of Trustees of the Field Museum of Chicago, a board member of The Executives' Club of Chicago and is a member of the Chicago Network, an organization of Chicago's most influential women. She is a past Director of Genzyme Corporation where she was a member of the Audit Committee and chaired the Risk Management Committee.

Ms. Boudreaux has been honored in 2008, 2009 and 2010 as one of *Fortune's* 50 Most Powerful Women in American Business. Additionally, she was named to the Forbes 100 Most Powerful Women list and was recognized by the Minneapolis / St. Paul Business Journal as one of the top 25 industry leaders. Ms. Boudreaux was also named by Modern Healthcare as one of the Most Powerful People in Healthcare.
